

## Cobb County School District 2016 CCRPI Brief

The College and Career Ready Performance Index or CCRPI is Georgia’s accountability measure that is used to determine how well schools, districts, and the state are preparing students for the next educational level. This brief provides CCRPI scores of all schools in the Cobb County School District in one document. One group of tables in this brief (see list below) provides a comparison of CCRPI scores from 2015 and 2016 for each school. A second group of tables provides each of the components of the 2016 CCRPI scores for each school.

Significant changes were made to the CCRPI in 2015 so that CCRPI scores before 2015 are too different to be usefully compared to those from 2015 and 2016. Therefore, only scores from 2015 and 2016 are included in this brief. Also, the state averages for each level in this document include exceeding the bar points to make the state averages comparable to the CCRPI scores from individual schools.

### How is CCRPI calculated?

The CCRPI is scored on a 100-point scale. The score is calculated from three separately weighted components: achievement (50 points), progress (40 points), and achievement gap (10 points). Up to 10 bonus points, called challenge points, can also be earned by schools. Achievement measures the academic achievement of students in a school for the current academic year. Various measures of academic achievement are used including the Georgia Milestones assessments, measures of school readiness and performance like reading ability and attendance, and for high schools the high school graduation rate. Progress measures the growth that students demonstrate on the Georgia Milestones from one year to the next. Achievement gap measures the achievement and progress of the lowest-achieving 25% of students in a school compared to the average students in the state. Challenge points are awarded for the performance of certain subgroups on the Milestones (ED/EL/SWD Performance) and for innovative practices in place at a school (Exceeding the Bar points). To alleviate the effects of highly mobile student populations on the CCRPI, students are only included in the CCRPI calculations if they have been enrolled for 65% or more of the appropriate school term.
