- Waiting on architects for new gym.
- Working on changing the Magnet Building into the FTA Building. The Old Magnet building will be the Freshman Classes. The Architects for the building came in today and looked at the new facility to determine what needs to occur. Mr. Perry stated that the global shipping issue has been a problem and delaying projects.

• SCHS Foundation campaign

- South Cobb Foundation campaign tries to get sponsorships and large donation for what SPLOST will not cover. The first month of the year, flyers and graphics will be created to go out to the community. There is a wish list of items that total to be \$100,000.
- There will be a giving campaign that will go towards the school.
 - The completion of painting the stadium and the logo. To finish the paining of the logo will be 10,000.
 - Mr. Perry stated that he is wanting to get a new electronic Marquee for the school which will cost about \$50,000.
 - In addition, he stated that he would like to see carpet placed in rooms with carpet at the cost of about \$60,000.
 - Charging stations for laptops are much needed. He stated that about 1,300 students have opted-in to receive a device, which is average across the county.
 - The blue wind screen at the stadium needs repair. He stated that this is something that will cost around \$7,000 to accomplish this.
