# Sprayberry High School Advanced Placement Final Exam Exemption

# Incentive and Contract 2019-2020

Sprayberry High School has implemented an Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Exemption Incentive. For students to participate in this incentive, both the parent and student must read and sign this contract. As this is a school-wide incentive, only one contract per student, per academic year is required. Students need only return this contract to one of their AP teachers, no later than November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2019 for Fall semester classes and April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 for Spring semester classes. AP students can exempt multiple AP Final Exams and this does not count as one of their exemptions allowed by the school (on-level/honors courses).

#### Requirements

- The student meets certain requirements including:
  - Must NOT have had any ISS or OSS
  - Must NOT have had more than 3 total absences for the class exam in which they are exempting (School Activities such as field trips and sporting events are **not** included in the 3 allotted absences)
- A final grade of an A <u>or</u> B in the course is required for final exam exemption. Students who exempt the final exam for the class do **not** have to come to school during the class period in which the final exam is administered.
- If a student wishes to exempt the final exam for a Fall semester AP course, then he/she **must** sign up and pay for the AP Exam by **November 8, 2019 at 9:00 p.m.** If a student wishes to exempt the final exam for a Spring semester AP course, then he/she **must** sign up and pay for the AP Exam by **February 28**<sup>th</sup>, **2020 at 9:00 p.m.**

## Failure to take AP Exam in May 2020

- Any student who fails to appear for the AP Exam in May 2020, will have his/her final exam grade for the class retroactively changed to a zero and their Official Georgia Standard Student Transcript will be updated to reflect the new, lower grade for that course. The student will have the opportunity to take the course final exam, if appropriate arrangements are made with the course teacher. It is the responsibility of the student to set up the date and time (prior to the end of the school year) to take the final exam with the assigned teacher, and the date and time will be at the discretion of the course teacher.
- If a student who has an A or B signs up and pays to take the AP Exam, but opts to take the final exam as well, he/she will receive no penalty for his/her ambition. If a student does not end up taking the AP Exam, and took the final, then the grade earned for the final will be recorded in the gradebook.

#### Exam Review Suggestions

- It is strongly recommended that you attend review sessions with your AP teacher throughout the Fall and Spring semesters based on their tutoring arrangements. This may be through Academic Opportunity (AO) sessions, before/after school tutoring, and Saturday sessions.
- Fall semester students should keep in touch with their AP teacher during the Spring semester to take advantage of review resources and sessions.

#### Sign Up for the AP Exam
