Sora is a resource in the Cobb Digital Library. There is also a free app you can download to your devices and login. Sora is an online library of ebooks and e-audiobooks. Below are the login directions and how you can connect to the public library. Please remember, it is a library, so there are only so many copies of each book. You can put holds on books if they are checked out.

- There is a district collection of hundreds of ebooks and e-audiobooks all students can have access to.
  Additionally, some schools also have a local collection available to students too.
- Access to titles is determined by school level: ES will see only ES books; MS will see MS and ES books;
  HS will see all titles.
- You can also connect your account to the Cobb County Public Library.
- The district collection is made up of award winners, Helen Ruffin list, Georgia Peach Award list, Tome list, popular titles, and classics. There are a lot of e-audiobooks easy to download and listen on devices and students can pair with print books.

- 3. Choose Cobb County School District






