The Cobb County School District (CCSD) currently offers **THREE** Georgia Pre-K classes at the South Cobb Early Learning Center (5891 Dodgen Road, Mableton, GA 30126). Georgia's Pre-K Program is a lottery funded educational program for four-year-old children to prepare them for kindergarten. CCSD is excited to announce that After School Care will be available for the 2022-23 school year. If your student is eligible and interested, we encourage all families to apply.

- CCSD's Pre-K follows the district calendar
- Students must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2022
- South Cobb Early Learning Center is the only location for GA Pre-K
- Families are required to provide their own transportation to and from SCEL
- Student Documents needed for registration:
 1. Certified Birth Certificate
 2. Social Security Card
 3. Current Immunization Record on Form 3231
 4. Hearing, Vision, Dental & Nutrition Screening on Form 3300
 5. Proof of Residency



Funding for GA's Pre-K Program is awarded by the Department of Early Care and Learning (DECAL). As CCSD's student allotment is limited, an enrollment lottery will be conducted to determine admission. Families will be notified by April 8, 2022 if accepted into CCSD's existing GA Pre-K classrooms. Other students will be placed on the waitlist. If our DECAL expansion application is approved, enrollment in the expansion class will follow the waitlist order. Those notifications will be made as soon as CCSD receives a decision from DECAL. CCSD will not be responsible for providing an alternative Pre-K experience for your child. Families are encouraged to explore all options for GA Pre-K for the 2022-23 school year.
