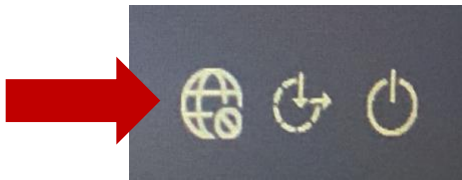
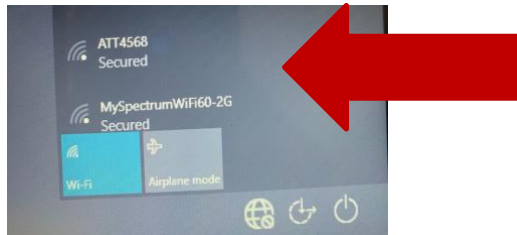


Distributed Device Wifi Connection: Windows Laptop

1. Power on laptop. DO NOT log in.
2. From your device's log in screen, select the Wi-Fi icon located on the bottom right of your screen.



3. Make sure Wi-Fi is available and you know your home Wi-Fi name and password.



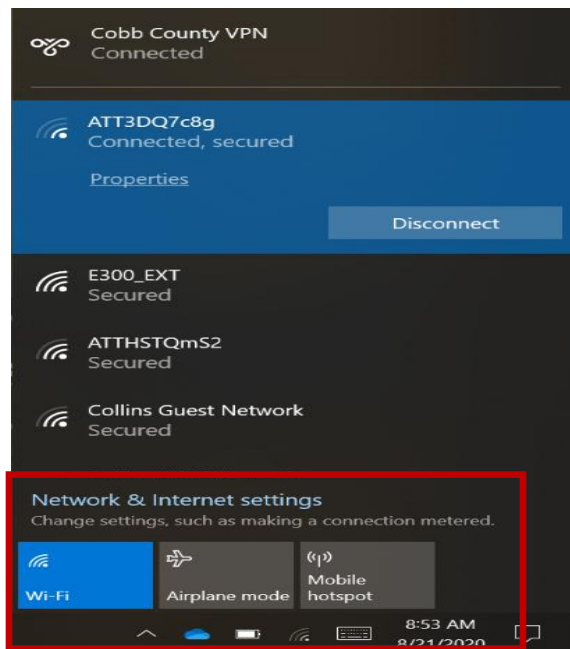
4. Select your home Wi-Fi network, enter the password, check the 'Connect Automatically' box then click Connect.
5. Log in to laptop.

How to Troubleshoot your WiFi Connection

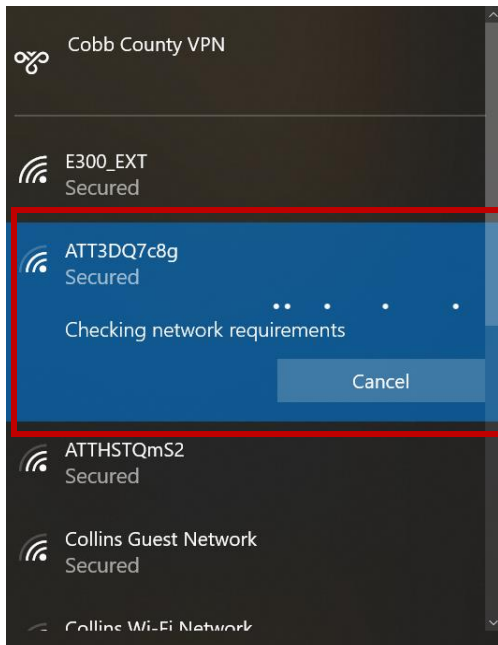
1. Make sure your wireless connection is on.



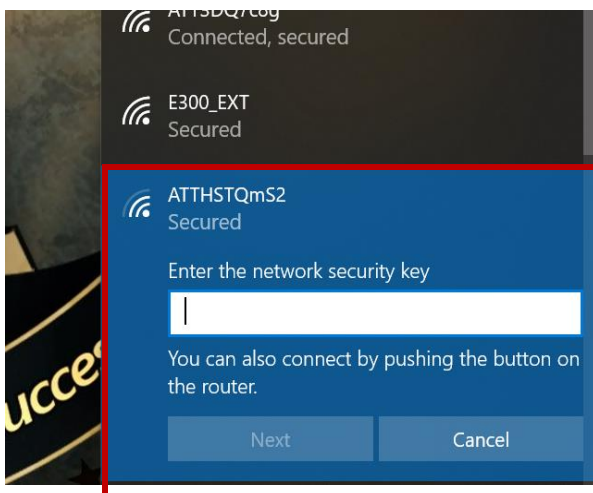
2. If you are not connected to the internet.
Click on the *wireless icon*. This will display the Network and Internet settings. The bottom of the menu shows *Wi-Fi*, *Airplane mode* and *Mobile hotspot*.
Press the **Fn key + Home key** to toggle between the three choices.
Select **Wi-Fi** from the choices. The box will turn blue.



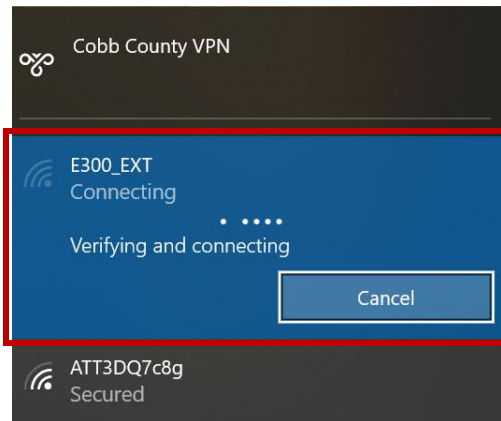
3. Next, select your internet provider / router. It will display Checking network requirements.



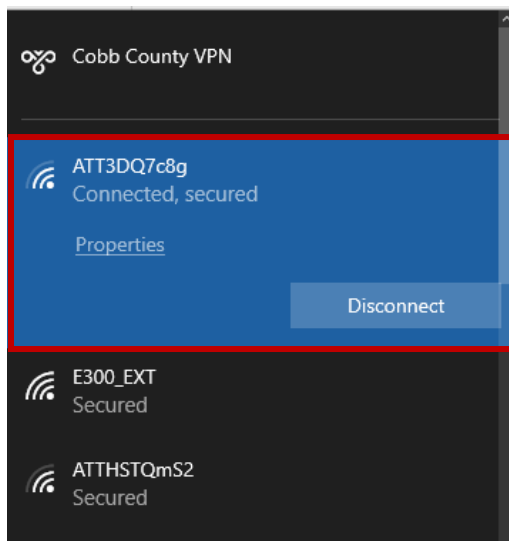
4. If the screen prompts for a password. *Type your network security key*. This will connect your computer to your internet provider.



5. The screen will display Verifying and connecting.



6. Once connected the screen will display the following.



7. Congratulations, you are now connected to the internet.

8. If you have followed these instructions and still cannot connect.
Turn off and restart the router. Then try these steps again.
