Lunch Changes for 2022-2023

As you are aware, schools have been able to offer breakfast and lunch at no charge to students during the last two school years. This was made possible thanks to the generous support of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) reimbursing schools for meals served to students, regardless of their income. The USDA is no longer able to provide no cost meals to all students. Cobb County School District will be returning to the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). The National School Lunch Program offers meals to students for a paid, free, or reduced-price cost based on income eligibility. The cost of the meal will be shared soon. Families can apply for benefits by completing and submitting a Family Meal Application.

For the 2022-2023 school year, Cobb County School District is requesting families whose income may qualify them for Free and/or Reduced-price meal benefits to complete and submit a Free and Reduced Meal Application. The Family Meal Application can be completed online by visiting the link:
