		Students do not have to be identified as "gifted" to be placed in Advanced Content (AC) courses. Administration makes placement decisions based on Dickerson's placement criteria and available standardized test scores.			
		Students who are identified as gifted must be served in a minimum of one AC course. Placement for gifted students is			
		determined by Dickerson's placement criteria.			
		Cobb County automatically screens students for gifted eligibility in K, 1 st , 3 rd , 5 th , and 7 th grades. If your student has been in			
		CCSD, they have already been screened for gifted services.

 - Nationally Normed Test Scores (within TWO years old)
 - Report cards from their previous school (We need to calculate a TWO year GPA when possible)

Students new to Dickerson from another country:

□ Student records will be reviewed for placement and may be referred for gifted testing during Window II.

Option A. Psychometric Measure: Criteria governing eligibility under option A:

A student must meet criteria in both assessment categories.

Option B. Multiple Criteria (for assessment categories): Criteria governing eligibility under option B:

- A student must meet criteria in any three of the four assessment categories.
- A nationally-normed test must be used for at least one assessment category.
- A rating scale may be used to establish eligibility in only one assessment category.
