



READY, SET... READ![BIRTH TO 12 MONTHS FAMILY CHECKLIST AND GUIDE]

FAMILY CHECKLIST:

- Do you have books with simple, large pictures with bright colors for your baby to enjoy?
- Are your child's books stiff cardboard books that can be propped up in the crib?
- When choosing books for your child, do you select those that are made of cloth or soft vinyl?
- Does your child have books with photos of familiar objects like balls and bottles?
- ➤ Does your child have plastic/vinvl books for bath time?
- X Does your child have washable books to cuddle and mouth?

TIPS FOR FAMILIES:

- Read to your child daily to build language, develop vocabulary and provide an opportunity for parent and child to bond. This develops early literacy skills and social-emotional skills needed for optimal learning to occur. Cloth or vinyl books are great books that can be used for reading with young babies.
- Sing, recite nursery rhymes, and talk to your baby about things they see or experience to develop early literacy and critical thinking skills.
- ★ Always read to your baby and your baby will one day read to you!
