Athletic Accomplishments

Hillgrove athletics compete in the highest classification 7A in the state of Georgia. Our teams include Cross Country, Tennis, Basketball, Soccer, Lacrosse, Volleyball, Football, flag football Swimming, Wrestling, Baseball, Softball, Track/Field, Golf, and Cheerleading. Our athletic teams have competed in both region and state tournaments and boast numerous region championships and recently added state championships in flag football and girls track. Our athletes have earned athletic scholarships to compete at the next level. It also is an honor for Hillgrove Athletics to have some alumni to go on and have professional careers.

Navy JROTC Accomplishments

Hillgrove's Navy JROTC is a Distinguished Unit with Academic Honors for 9 straight years and is the ranked unit in the state of GA. NJROTC competes in Academics, Air Rifle, Athletics, Drone, Military Drill, and Orienteering with numerous regional, state and national championships titles. The Academic Team won the 2018 State Championship and the Drill Team was State Runner-up in 2023. The Orienteering Team won the 2018, 2020, 2021, and 2023 State Championships, as well as the 2019, 2022, and 2023 National Orienteering Championships in Agua Dulce, CA, San Jose, CA, and Winder, GA, respectively; they are the current 3X defending National Champions. NJROTC is a civic-based leadership development program that allows students to grow as leaders and servants in their local community, completing roughly 3000 hours of community and school service annually.

Fine Arts Accomplishments

The Hillgrove Fine Arts programs have been recognized for achievements at the State, National and International levels. The Visual Art program maintains an active National Art Honors Society and showcases work at local, state, and national art exhibitions. The Drama Program maintains an active chapter of the International Thespian Society and has performed at numerous conferences and competitions. The Band, Chorus and Orchestra programs have all performed at the GMEA State Conference. The Marching Band has been recognized as finalists at Bands of America and the Wind Symphony was a National winner at the Wind Band Honors Competition. The Hillgrove Bands and Orchestras have traveled internationally for concert tours in China and France. The Symphony Orchestra has performed at national festivals in prestigious venues such as the Kennedy Center in Washington DC, Orchestra Hall in Chicago, and Carnegie Hall in New York.


