We are accredited by the Southern Association. Over the years, we have repeatedly been awarded the Georgia Public School of Excellence award and have been named a National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence.

Cobb County Schools: A District of Distinction

The Cobb County School District is the second largest school system in Georgia and the 28th largest in the United States. Its student population grows by nearly 2,500 each year.

Curriculum

Due to the level of difficulty, some courses receive extra weight in calculating a student's grade point average (GPA). Additional quality points are calculated into the overall GPA and are not reflected in the numerical averages. Classes meet on average of 52 minutes, 5 days a week for 18 weeks (one semester). Our innovative Academic Support and Enrichment (ASE) program is made available 3 days a week for 30 minutes to allow students to receive assistance for course work and high-stakes testing. Enrichment opportunities for Advanced Placement courses and academic clubs are also offered during the ASE period. There are two semesters in the August - May school year. Credit is granted for each semester independently of any other semester.
