

Lovinggood Middle School 6th Grade Supply List 2023-2024

This list contains the supplies most students will need for the school year.

Individual classroom needs may vary slightly.

*We recommend that students bring only a folder, paper and pencil the first few days of school until final requirements are shared by teachers.

* We strongly encourage all 6th grade students to use an agenda to help with organizational skills.

Social Studies:

Chafin:5 folders with prongs and pockets (students will only need to carry one folder at a time throughout the year – (1 per unit), 25-page protectors in each folder's prongs, 1 pack (100) count plastic sheet covers

Kriz: Folder or 3 ring binder with page protectors

Hague: Mead 5-star spiral notebook (college ruled, perforated pages), 3-5 sections **OR** sturdy, 3 ring binder with plastic page protectors (100)

All Science: One pocket folder, notebook paper, 1 pack of page protectors (optional)

All Math: One wide or college ruled composition notebook (100 pages) One pocket folder, & a Basic 4 function calculator

All Language Arts: 1 composition book required & notebook paper.

One pencil pouch (labeled with student's name) to contain the following items:

- Blue or black ink pens, pencils, and erasers (enough to last school year)
- Hand-held pencil sharpener
- Colored pencils
- Dry erase markers (4 to 6), highlighters
- Glue sticks (large size preferred) or scotch tape
- Small scissors
- Notebook paper (wide of college ruled)
- Index cards
- Earbuds/headphones (as requested by teacher/media specialist)

Daily Agenda for writing down assignments and due dates or you may use CTLS digital calendar, whichever is the preferred method for your student.
