Dear parents/guardians of rising 6th graders – Moving to middle school is a big step! One of the many keys to success in middle school is organization, and the 6th grade teachers want your child's first experience at Hightower Trail to be a positive one. ITEMS NEEDED ON A DAILY BASIS (replenish as needed):

- 1 pair of scissors (Fiskars 12+)
- 1 TI-30XIIS scientific calculator
- 4 glue sticks
- Lots of #2 pencils
- Pens (blue or black)
- 2 packs of **colored** pencils
- 2 black sharpies (1 **thin** and 1 **thick**)
- 2 **composition** notebooks – NO spiral
- 2 packs of index cards (3x5 inch size)
- 2 packs of college-ruled notebook paper
- Hand-held, enclosed pencil sharpener
- Headphones or ear buds (standard headphone jack)
- Highlighters (1 each of pink, orange, yellow, green, and blue)
- 2 **three-subject plastic-covered college-ruled** spiral notebooks
- 5 **plastic** pocket folders with prongs – see colors below
 - Red (math), yellow (reading), green (science), blue (social studies), purple (ELA)
- Pencil pouch (**soft-sided/fabric**) – to carry all supplies needed for each class (pencils, pens, highlighters, scissors, glue stick)

Bring on the 1st day of school:

1. Bookbag
2. Lunch (or \$ in account)
3. 5 folders
4. Pencil pouch with pencils, pens, highlighters, scissors, and glue stick
