

# **Advanced Content in Elementary School**

## What are the recommended guidelines for $4^{th}$ grade placement?

It is strongly recommended that students have an IOWA *Total Reading or Total Math* percentile score of 80% or higher. Students with an EOG designation of *Basic* or *Developing* are not eligible to participate.

### AC Reading/ELA -

4<sup>th</sup> grade students must have a minimum of 9 points to qualify for AC coursework in this subject.
