Dreambox	<p>If you have a Cobb County iPad, please make sure you have the Dreambox App. To install the app if you do not have it</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Find the Cobb County app. It is black and red 2. Open the county app 3. Scroll down and find Dreambox 4. Click on it 5. Click install 6. You will receive a pop up message that reads “The request to install the application called “Dreambox Learning Math” succeeded 7. It can take up to 24 hours for the app to appear on the device <p>To access Dreambox for an assignment on the iPad</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Click on the Clever app (it is blue and white) 2. Login to Clever 3. Select the Dreambox icon in Clever 4. This will launch the app for you, and your assignment will come up. <p><u>If you go to Dreambox.com or just click on the app for Dreambox, it will NOT work. You MUST go through Clever.</u></p>
