Frequently Asked Questions about Baccalaureate

<u>What is it?</u> Baccalaureate is an inspirational service designed to encourage graduates to live their faith beyond high school.

Who may attend? The service is open to all MHS Seniors, their family and friends.

How much does it cost? There is no cost.

<u>Do I need a ticket?</u> No ticket is required. This is an opportunity for family and friends who cannot attend the graduation ceremony due to the limited number of tickets given per student or scheduling problems to say congratulations by their attendance.

How many people may attend? There is no limit, the sanctuary seats 1000.

<u>What do I wear?</u> Seniors are to wear their stole and gown only, no cap. The cap to your gown is not necessary for this event. Wear what you would be wearing to graduation *except for any additional stoles, cords, medals, etc.* as this is a celebration of your spiritual journey and not about the individual accomplishments. Friends and family should dress in clothes appropriate for the occasion.

<u>What time do I arrive?</u> Seniors should arrive at **1:30 PM**. to line up for the processional. Those performing in the service arrive at **1:00 PM**. **Service will start promptly at 2:00 PM**.
