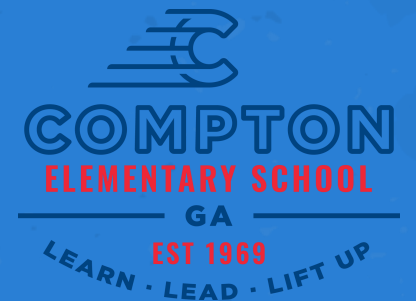

2023-2024 SCHOOLWIDE GOALS

Literacy Goal

- **The number of students performing on or above grade level reading proficiency utilizing the Benchmark Assessment System will increase from 160 (51%) kindergarten - 2nd grade students as demonstrated in May 2023 to 176 (56%) kindergarten - 2nd grade students as demonstrated by May 2024.**
- **The number of students performing on or above grade level reading proficiency utilizing the Reading Inventory will increase from 149 (55%) 3rd- 5th grade students on the May 2023 RI to 162 (60%) 3rd-5th grade students by the May 2024 RI.**

Math Goal


- **The number of students performing on or above grade level math proficiency utilizing the Math Inventory will increase from 298 (51%) 1st -fifth grade students as demonstrated on the May 2023 MI Assessment to 330 (57%) kindergarten-fifth grade students as demonstrated by May 2024 MI Assessment.**

Writing Goal

- **Utilizing September 2023 Write Score Baseline Assessment in 2nd-5th Grades, forty percent or more 2nd-5th (153) grade students will perform on or above grade level writing proficiency as measured by the Spring 2024 Write Score Assessment.**
