- After completion: Diploma, Associates Degree, or work.

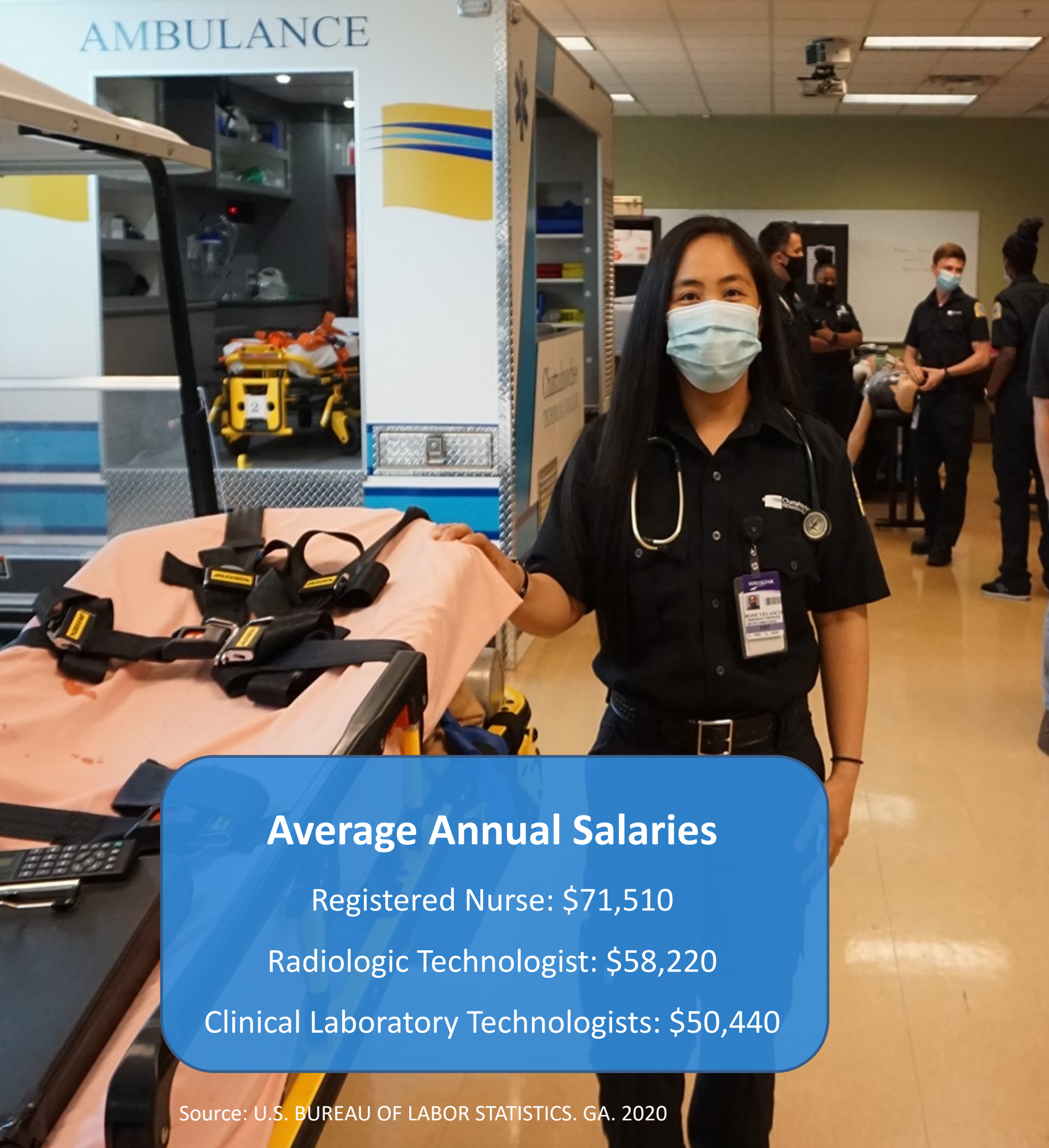
## Diplomas

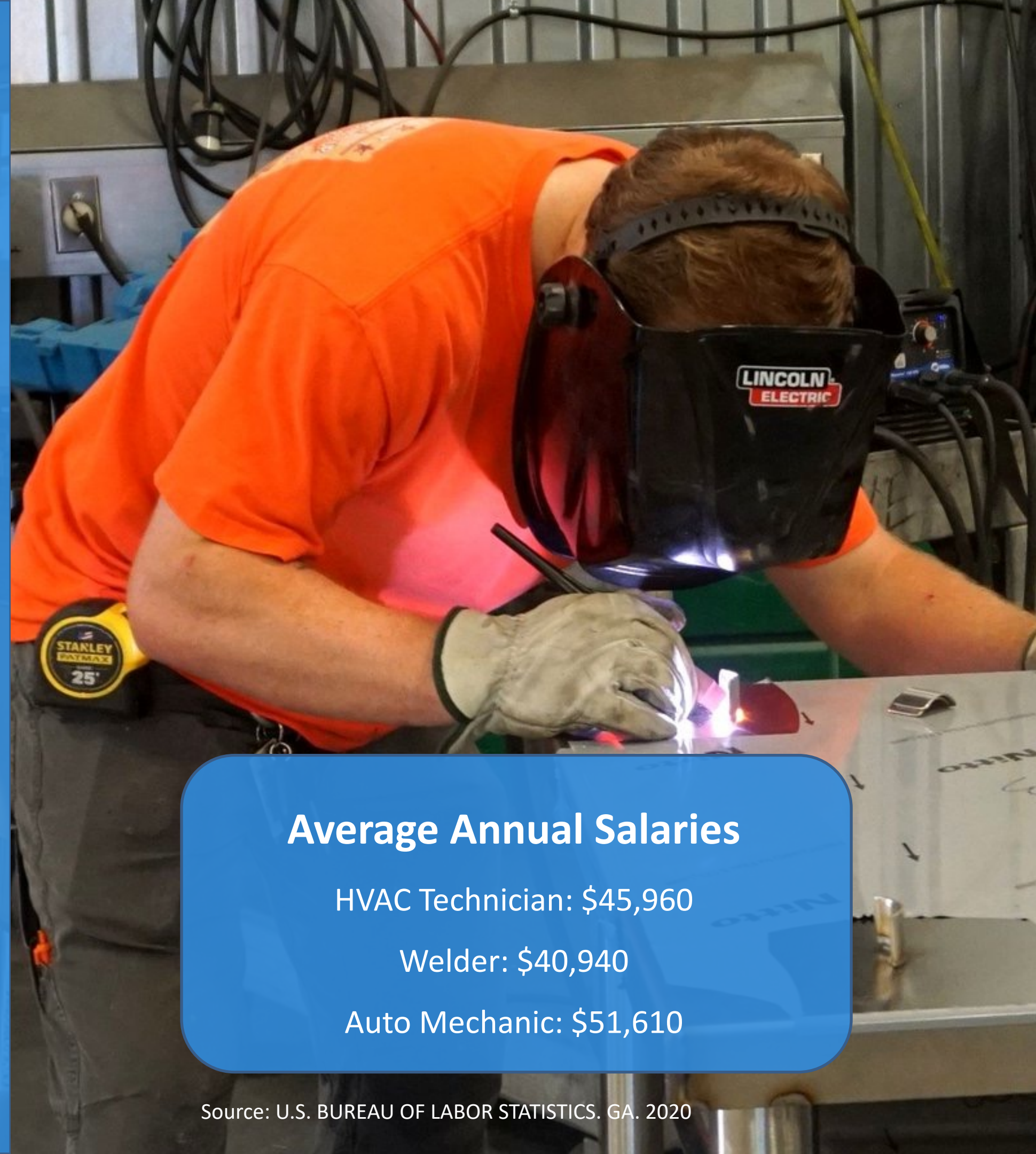

# Who is eligible for Dual Enrollment?

**10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade is eligible.**

- **10th Grade is eligible for CTAE Courses**

CORE classes: Require min SAT score of 1200 or min ACT composite score of 26 in a single national test administration

- **11th and 12th Grade is eligible for ANY course in the directory** ([gafutures.org](http://gafutures.org))



# DE Funding

- Tuition, mandatory fees & textbooks are 100% covered by DE Funding for the first 30 credit hours.
- Textbooks/Access Codes are provided by college library using DE Funding.
- Course specific fees may apply and are the responsibility of the student. i.e. (Cosmetology, Auto, Welding, etc.)
- Completed/Approved DE funding application is required once per school year on [Gafutures.org](https://gafutures.org) ("Funding Year" begins in Summer Semester)
- All course must be on the College Course Directory for DE funding approval on [Gafutures.org](https://gafutures.org)



# After 30 Hours of DE Funding is used...

## HOPE Grant/HOPE Career Grant

- Student must be participating in Hope Career Grant Eligible Program
- Student must meet HOPE Residency Requirements
- Students are responsible for paying tuition, required fees, and textbooks/access code costs, and any costs not covered by the HOPE Grant/Hope Career Grant
- Students who use the HOPE Grant/HOPE Career Grant must meet HOPE residency requirements.

– Any HOPE Career Grant or HOPE Grant hours used will count against HOPE and Zell Miller Scholarships cap.

## Self-Pay

10–12th graders who are not eligible for dual enrollment funding or HOPE Grant/HOPE Career Grant can cover their Dual Enrollment courses by choosing to pay for their classes.

They will be responsible for all tuition, fees, and textbook/access code costs.

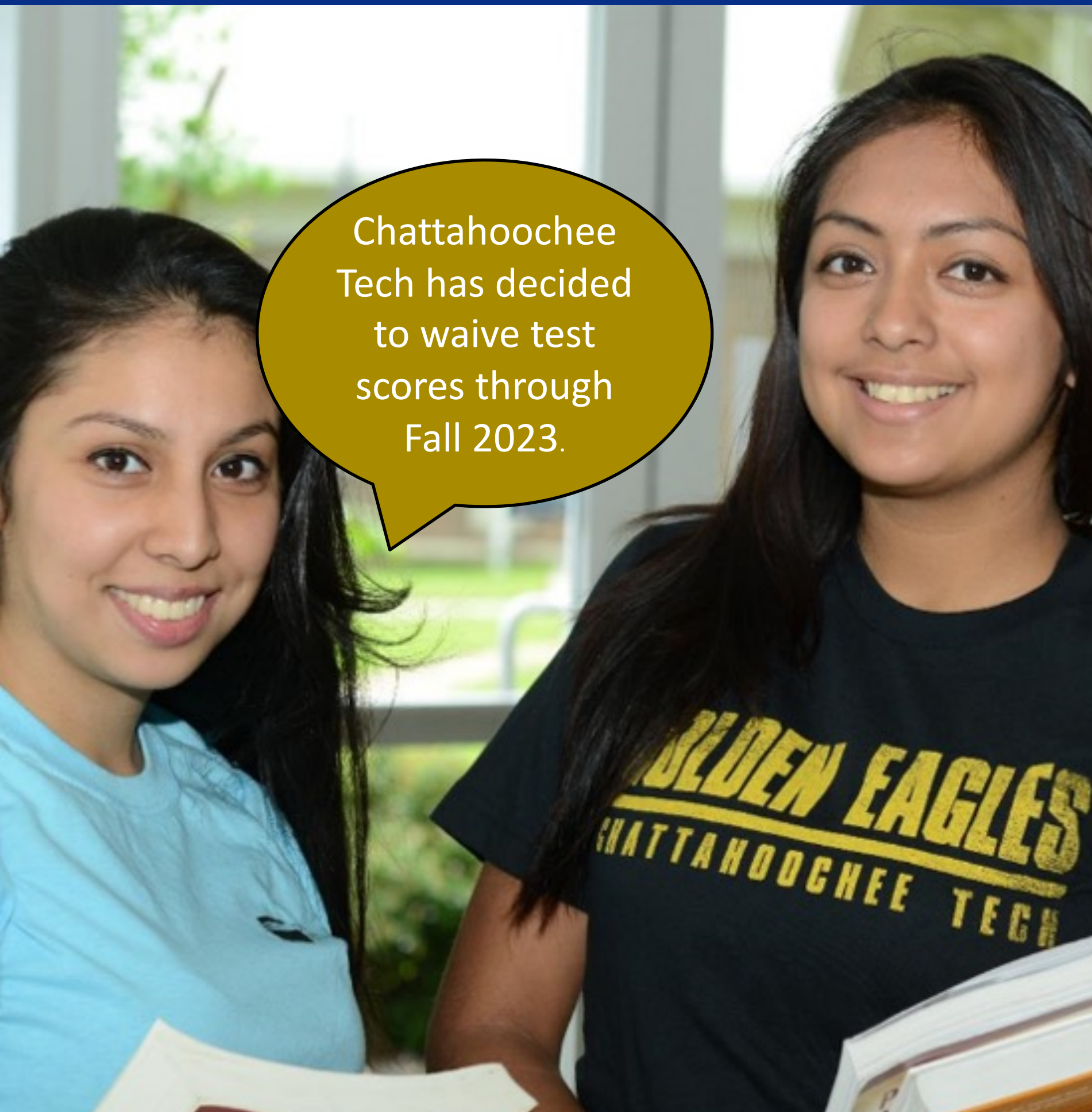
