Dress Code

As required by board policy – students at Clay-Harmony Leland Elementary School are expected to dress in a manner that supports a positive learning environment that is free of distractions and disruptions. All students shall maintain the following minimum standard of dress:

- 1. Appropriate shoes shall be worn.
- Midriffs shall be covered.
- 3. Appropriate under-garments shall be worn and may not be visible.
- 4. Strapless garments shall be worn with a jacket.
- 5. Tank-tops shall be worn with a jacket.
- 6. Appropriate shorts, as determined by the school administration, may be worn (fingertip length).
- 7. No caps, hats, bandanas nor hoods covering the head are to be worn in the school buildings during the school day unless there is a special activity during which they are deemed appropriate by the school administration.
- 8. Clothing or ornamentation that does any of the following is prohibited:
- a. Displays or advertises substances illegal for minors.
- b. Displays suggestive phrases, designs, markings, or profanities.
- c. Advocates, promotes, or suggests illegal activity.
