



FAQ for Elective Registration 2023/2024

How many electives do I select for the school year?

Students will have the opportunity to select elective request choices until they reach 8 total classes and 4 alternates. Based on availability of seats, you may receive your 8th choice, so choose wisely.

What if I want to change my electives after I have submitted my choices?

Students are expected to honor their course requests. There are specific requirements to be met for a class change to be honored.

What if I want to change my core recommendation?

The core course waiver window will open February 9, 2023 and run through February 19, 2023. If you would like to waive up or down from your recommended core course, you will need to complete the online waiver change form found on the KMHS Curriculum and Scheduling website.

All core waiver requests are due by February 19, 2023.

What if I get an elective I did not register for?

Once student schedules are completed, there is a chance you are given that was not one of your top 8 choices. In that instance, the scheduling team had to make a decision to complete your schedule due to scheduling conflicts.

What if I am signing up for a yearlong course like Band, Orchestra, Chorus, etc.?

If selected into the audition or application-based program, this course will count for two electives for the school year. If you are scheduled for a yearlong course, you are expected to remain in that class for the entire school year.

How do I take the classes listed as Application Only?

(Minimum Morning/Day, Yearbook, WBL -Work Based Learning, etc.)

You will find links to all application courses on the scheduling website (located on the KMHS website). Acceptance into the class will replace other elective choices but does not guarantee placement due to scheduling conflicts.

Where can I find the Course Catalog for the 2023/2024 school year?

Are there grade level restrictions?

Yes, there are some electives specifically designed for upperclassmen such as Minimum Morning/Day, Mentorship, and Work Based Learning. Please see course catalog for restrictions.

What is a pre-requisite?

A course that is required to be passed before a student can progress to a higher-level course. Students are removed from courses they do not meet the pre-requisite(s) for and will not have the opportunity to select an alternative elective course in its place.

How many classes do I need to pass to complete a pathway requirement?

Three courses must be completed in the same pathway. An “end of pathway assessment” may also be required. Please make sure to refer to the course catalog so you understand what the class is about before you request it.
