ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Cell phones must be turned off and placed in the student's backpack. According to state law, students may have cell phones at school as long as they are not used during school hours and on buses. CD Players, MP3 Players, IPods, Gaming Devices or other electronic items of distractions are not permitted at Tapp Middle School. Students may not wear headphones or Airpods in the building. <u>The school is not responsible for the loss, damage or theft of</u> <u>any of the above items. All items left unclaimed at the end of the school year</u> <u>will be donated to a local charity.</u>

If a student is found to be in use of a cell phone or the phone is not stored in their backpack, the student will receive the following consequences:
