- NO Required Summer Reading

- Genre based (novel, poetry, short story, drama, epic poem) units
- Designed for independent reader
- In-class literary analysis and annotation

11th Grade **Honors** American Literature and Composition

Description

- Teacher recommendation
- Self-reader/motivated
- Required summer reading

Class Structure

- Chronological survey of American Literature with added film-study
- Required to know historically significant author names and what they wrote
- In-class analysis and annotation
- Outside reading/study required
- Recommended flashcards/quizlet work

Writing Requirements

- MLA knowledge required
- Multiple timed paragraphs (6+)
- Analysis Research Essay (1)
- Narrative writings (2)

11th Grade **AP Lang**: American Non-Fiction and Composition

Description

- Academically rigorous (+1 on GPA)
- Preparation for EOC
- College credit dependent on individual schools and scores

Pre-requisite

- Honors 10th Lit/Comp
- Teacher recommendation
- Self-reader/motivated
- Required summer reading

Class Structure

- Intense, college-level reading and writing assignments
- In-depth analysis/insight/annotation required while reading
- Outside reading required (significantly more than the other courses)
- Practice on multiple choice AP pre-tests

Writing Requirements

- MLA knowledge required
- Multiple timed essays on AP prompts
- Research project

Description

- Academically challenging
- Preparation for college/career in film
- 1 English and 1 Fine Arts credit

Pre-requisite

- 11th Lit
- No summer reading

Class Structure

- Theme- or genre-based units

Writing Requirements

- Narrative writings
- Analytical Writings
- Poetic Writing
- Dramatic Writing for stage and screen
- Constantly writing!

Sample Texts (22-23 year)

- Choice fiction text for analysis

- 11th Lit
- No summer reading

Class Structure

- Theme- or genre-based units
- Projects (group or individual)
- Multimodal expressions

Writing Requirements

- MLA knowledge required
- Multimodal argument
- Analysis Research – technical writing: podcast, docushort or zine articles
- Script writing
- Creative writing pieces
- Visual text arguments
- Lengthy narrative writings

Description

- Honors or AP 11th Lit
- Teacher recommendation
- Self-reader/motivated
- Required summer reading

Class Structure

- Intense, college-level reading and writing assignments
- In-depth analysis/insight/annotation required while reading
- Outside reading required (more than other classes)

Writing Requirements

- Multiple timed essays on AP prompts
- Narrative essay
- Research project/MLA
