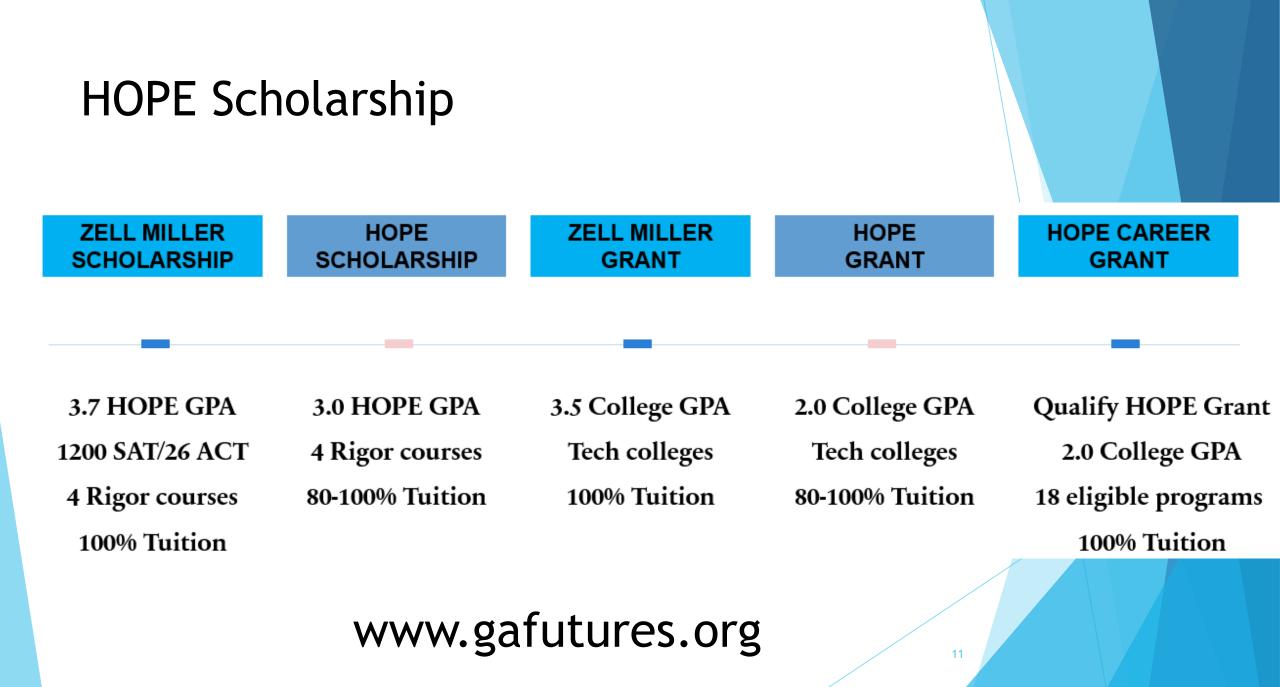
Fine Art Courses:

- World Language Courses (plan on 2 same lang. minimum if going to college)
 - Spanish, German, French
 - GA Colleges will accept AP Computer Science Principles and AP Computer Science A for the World Language requirement, but out-of-state colleges may not

 - >\$275 per half credit
 - If taking a Foreign language course over the summer, we do not recommend continuing that course at Pope
 - Health and Personal Fitness will be offered face-to-face in June at Pope

Core: English, Math, Science, Social Studies & World Languages

□ AP, IB and Dual Enrollment: 0.5 weight

Does not go above 4.0

□ HOPE can be earned in college, if not earned with high school GPA

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HOPE Rigor

□ 4 courses of rigor required

Advanced Math: Alg. II or higher & Advanced Science

□ AP, IB and Dual Enrollment in <u>core</u> subjects
