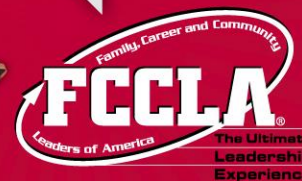

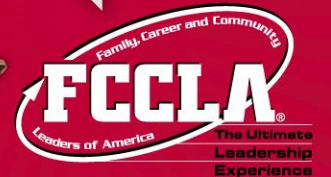

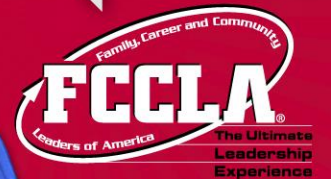

Club Dues: \$35.00- This includes all local, state and national dues and a t-shirt.



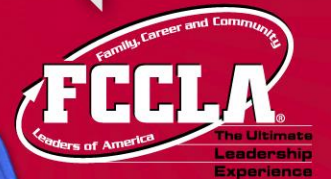
FCCLA's Mission

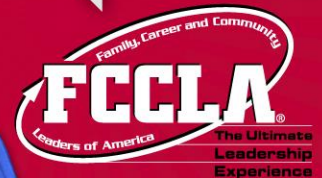
