

GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION AND USE OF SUPPLEMENTARY SCHOOL COUNSELING MATERIALS

1) Instructional materials which supplement the Cobb County School District School Counseling Comprehensive Guide may be utilized to assist in meeting the goals and objectives of the program.

2) All supplementary materials selected for use in the Cobb County School Counseling program shall be consistent with Cobb County School District Administrative Rules related to supplemental materials (see Administrative Rule IFAA-R).

3) All supplementary materials may include, but are not limited to: books, newspapers, magazines, videos, computer software, or worksheets. Only materials that will assist the student in achieving the goals and objectives of the School Counseling program shall be used.

4) Supplementary materials must be selected based on the following;

a) Content, concepts, procedures and vocabulary are consistent with the goals and objectives of the School Counseling program.

b) Professional discretion of the local school administrator and counselor must be used in the selection of materials which might include topics of a sensitive nature as perceived by the community served. The local school may contact the district's supervisor of School Counseling for consultation on the selection of these materials, if needed.
