PRE-COURSE ASSIGNMENTS

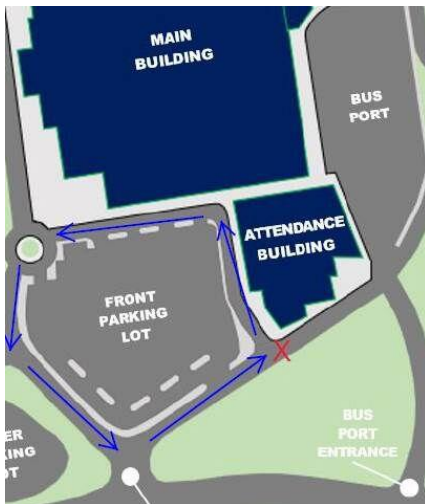
