LEBA Parental Involvement in Education 4/28/16

The Cobb County Board of Education (Board) believes family and community engagement is critical to student and district success. Through each respective School Strategic Plan, all schools shall establish programs and practices that enhance parental involvement and reflect the needs of the students and their families.

Additionally, the Board recognizes the importance and legal requirements for implementing programs, activities, and procedures for the involvement of parents in the Title I program. In compliance with the parental involvement provisions of Section 118 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA), the Cobb County School District and all Title I schools shall jointly develop with, and distribute to, parents of participating students, a written parental involvement policy.
