### 2021-2022District Goals

- Increase student performance in all core content areas by 2% annually as measured by achievement data.
- CCSD will increase the participation rate of families and communities engaging in services/programs by 10% as measured by CTLS Parent data, survey results & web view module.
- By 2023, we will reorganize the PL framework to meet the needs of all schools to ensure alignment with Superintendent Priorities as measured by PL opportunities, surveys, and student achievement.

### 2021–2022 School Goals

### What is Title I?

### Mableton Elementary is Branching Out!

Mableton Elementary will take the following measures to promote and support parents as an important foundation of the school in order to strengthen the school and reach our school goals. We will:

- Employ a Parent Facilitator to promote home-school connections.
- Ensure that all information related to school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities is published in both English and Spanish, posted on the school Web site.
- Provide trainings for staff during their planning periods on strategies to improve communication with parents and ideas to increase family engagement.
