Commencement Updates – Class of 2022

Additional Security Measures Required by Kennesaw State University:

*KSU now requires that EVERYONE entering the Convocation Center must pass through metal detectors for screening (staff, students, guests).

Changes to Bag Policy Required by Kennesaw State University:

*Guests entering the venue with a bag MUST have either a CLEAR TOTE or SMALL Clutch to be approved for entry into the venue. All bags and packages are subject to inspection by public safety personnel.
