It is important that you and your family review the following information carefully.

LOCATION OF VENUE AND DIRECTIONS

Cantrell Stadium is located on the campus of McEachern High School at 2400 New Macland Road, Powder Springs, GA 30127. From Macland Road turn south onto New Macland Road. From Richard D. Sailors Parkway, turn north onto New Macland Road.

TICKET ALLOCATION FOR COMMENCEMENT

- All tickets will be distributed at the final commencement practice on Wednesday, May 22.
- Everyone entering the commencement ceremony must have a ticket. This includes small children and babies.
- Students requested tickets via the Student Portal; however, the number of tickets requested are not guaranteed.
- In the event of inclement weather on the morning of May 23, the ceremony will be held inside the Lovinggood Gym. Students will receive <u>four</u> tickets per graduate to use for the <u>Lovinggood Gym</u> ceremony only.

HONOR GRADUATES

Students with a minimum of 3.500 cumulative GPA (not rounded) will receive their honor cords at the final commencement practice of May 22. The final transcript will be delivered along with the diploma after commencement.

SENIOR CLEARANCE

- A letter will be sent out to each student indicating their fines by April 19, 2024.
- All fees for lost or damaged textbooks, media materials, district laptop, parking, classroom instructional equipment, uniforms, or any other materials owed to the school must be cleared by Friday, May 17, at 4:00 PM. Please see Mrs. Susan Harmon in the bookroom prior to May 17 to take care of such matters.
- Band, Orchestra, and Chorus fines must be paid in the Band Building. Please see Mr. Wilson.
- Fines can be paid in cash only in the bookroom or to the necessary party.
- Students with outstanding fees will be prohibited from participating in the commencement ceremony.

COMMENCEMENT PRACTICES

- Attendance at both commencement practices is a mandatory prerequisite for participation in the commencement ceremony.
- Students must be on time for practices. Cobb County School District and McEachern High School policies, rules, and regulations, including the dress code, are in effect at all commencement practices and the ceremony. Students must have met all financial obligations prior to the first practice.
- Practice dates and times are listed below:
 - Tuesday, May 21, 2024, 8:20 AM 11:00 AM in the Lovinggood Gym at McEachern High School
 - Wednesday, May 22, 2024, 8:20 AM 11:00 AM in the Lovinggood Gym at McEachern High School

COMMENCEMENT CAPS, GOWNS, AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

If you have questions concerning your order, contact the Herff Jones office at (770) 795-1626, or email at seniors@atlgrad.com. Each student should have a current gown, matching mortarboard, and tassel to participate in the ceremony.

COMMENCEMENT ATTIRE

Graduates are expected to wear academic attire available from the school's graduation vendor. Commencement is a formal ceremony of prestige and honor. To ensure the decorum of the ceremony and to provide consistency among schools, alterations to the mortarboard and gown will not be permitted. Graduates may only wear stoles, cords, and other insignia authorized by the school.

- Women are expected to wear dark slacks, a dress or a skirt and a blouse of any color with dress shoes. The dress may not hang below the gown. Flat shoes are recommended due to the distance graduates will walk from the Taylor Farm parking lot to the Lovinggood Gym (HPEW) and Cantrell Stadium.
- Men are expected to wear a collared shirt of any color with a tie, dark dress slacks, dress shoes.
- Only those in proper attire will be allowed in the processional. Flowers and large pieces
 of jewelry are not allowed. Remove your gown from the packaging prior to
 commencement and hang it up so wrinkles will fall out. Use a cool iron to press, if
 necessary. SLIPPERS, DECORATIONS OR ADORNMENTS ON CAPS OR GOWNS will not
 be permitted. You will not participate in the ceremony if you are not dressed
 appropriately!

COMMENCEMENT DAY

- On the day of commencement, graduates should park in the Taylor Farm Parking Lot, which is located by the track field on Brand Road. Students may not park on campus for this event. Every senior must be in the Lovinggood Gym by 7:45 AM on the day of commencement for line up.
- Parking for guests is available using entrances on New Macland Road and Gaydon Road.
 Accessible and special assistance parking will be available in front of the Performing Arts
 Center (PAC) using either the north entrance on New Macland Road or the northwest
 entrance on Gaydon Road. Officers will direct guests to parking. Overflow parking will
 be available in the Taylor Farm Parking Lot.
- Gates at Cantrell Stadium will open for individuals who need special assistance and seating at 8:00 AM. Otherwise, general admission entrance to the stadium begins at 8:15 AM. Guests with disabilities and elderly guests requiring individualized assistance may be seated on the field in the designated sections. Please complete the Graduation Special Seating form and submit to Mr. Lockhart no later than May 13, 2024, at 4:00 PM if applicable.

DIPLOMA DISTRIBUTION

All graduates will receive their official diploma in the McEachern cafeteria immediately following the conclusion of the commencement ceremony.

CONDUCT/EXPECTATIONS OF GRADUATES AND GUESTS

- All policies, rules, and regulations of McEachern High School and Cobb County School District will be enforced, especially dress code.
- Students must remain properly dressed throughout the ceremony, and they are expected to follow directions explained during rehearsal; otherwise, they will be excluded from the ceremony.
- Possession of any disruptive objects may lead to immediate removal from the ceremony.
- Balloons and signs will not be allowed in Cantrell Stadium.
- Students must arrive on time, follow directions, and cooperate fully during the rehearsal and the ceremony.
- Disruptive students will be removed and not allowed to participate in the ceremony.
- Restitution for any damage to the venue, district property, or vendor property will be the responsibility of the graduate(s) and/or audience who cause the damage.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Any object which obscures the view or impacts the safety of others is not allowed in any district-managed venue. A complete list of prohibited items is available on the district graduation web page (www.cobbk12.org/graduation).

COMMENCEMENT PHOTOS

- We have arranged for Cady Studios to take individual photographs of graduates as they
 receive their diplomas. Cady Studios will email to the parents a proof of this photo with
 ordering information.
- To our guests, only hand-held cameras that do not block the view of other guests may be used. No one will be allowed to set up cameras with tripods to video the ceremony. Also, the use of selfie sticks is prohibited inside and outside Cantrell Stadium.

- We will start process sing/sending final transcript requests on June 5, 2024. This transcript has your final grades and graduation date.
- All Final transcripts for colleges will be sent electronically via naviance.
 All Final transcripts for ncaa or naia will be uploaded to the ncaa or naia.
- You must use this form link to request your final transcript(s). You may visit the School Counseling Office in the Business Technology (BT) Building for assistance with this form.
 Please remember, you are allowed to receive ONE FREE Final Transcript. Each additional Final Transcript request is \$2.00 cash.
- You may pay for additional Final Transcripts by physically going to the School Counseling Office in the Business Technology (BT) Building and submit \$2.00 per transcript, in exact cash.
- We are unable to accept Mypaymentsplus/electronic payments after May 31, 2024 at 11:59 PM. All seniors will receive a copy of your unofficial final transcript when you pick up your diploma after graduation. Because this transcript is "unofficial", colleges will not accept it for final transcript verification.
- During the summer, the School Counseling Office is open most Wednesdays from 9 AM to 4 PM. with the exception of the week of July 4, 2024. The School Counseling Office will be closed from 12 PM. to 1 PM. for lunch.
- Please do not submit multiple requests for the same school. Submitting multiple requests will delay the process.

- You only need to submit this form one time for your ONE FREE transcript. Two additional FINAL transcripts may be requested on this form but <u>must be paid for in the School Counseling Office in the Business Technology (BT) Building</u>. You may request up to 3 Final transcripts on this form. If you need to request more than 3 FINAL transcripts, please resubmit a new form. In order to take advantage of your free final transcript, you must make your request by July 12, 2024. After July 12, 2024, you may come to the School Counseling Office in the Business Technology (BT) Building and pay in person or make your request on CCSD's records website:

- McEachern's School Counseling office will reopen for the 2024-2025 school year on July 25, 2024. The electronic transcript portal on the Naviance website will shut down for maintenance at the beginning of the 2024-2025 school year.
