

HOW DO I BECOME A NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY MEMBER?

Students with a 3.95 GPA or higher are eligible to apply starting their sophomore year, and each consecutive year after as long as the GPA requirement is met. Information about applying is available by early September each year. The application will be submitted through CTLS.

A faculty committee then reviews the student's application, which requires multiple parts aligning with the National Honor Society's foundation of service, scholarship, leadership, and character. Students, accepted and denied, are notified in October of the committee's decision. Applicants who are accepted are invited to become official members of NHS by turning in a society contract and dues. (Mid- End October). Induction of new members is held early November during Hawk Hour

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- 3.95 or higher weighted GPA
- No ISS (in-school suspension) or OSS (out-of-school suspension) infractions
- 10 hours of community service (2 of the 10 must be tutoring)
- Submission of the digital contract each year
- Pay membership dues through My Payments Plus each year
- New members must be accepted through the application process.
- Returning members do not need to reapply.
