- 1. School Updates: Mr. Perry began by thanking all members in attendance and explained that he cannot do this job alone. The PAC is made up of members of the school and community that can come together to help bounce ideas around and help make the best choices for our students, staff, and families. We want to enhance our students high school experience.
  - a. **Celebrations:** We have a 80.4% graduation rate, which is higher than pre-Covid.
  - b. Discipline Data: We have decreased anywhere from 22-27% on our discipline infractions when comparing FY23 & FY24. We are now a PBIS school, so we are focusing on positives. We have a certain expectation of students for not only academic, but behavior as well. By teaching them the expectations we want to see, we will hopefully help to shape more positive behavior across campus.
  - c. New Gym Construction Update: Not an official timeline yet, but hopefully will be complete by December of 2024. The gym sits off of campus a little bit, so construction is not impacted by students and vice versa.
  - d. **Parent University Sessions:** Like teaching "the whole student" we want to teach "the whole parent". Parent University will feature topics taught from those within the school as well as industry professionals in their field. The last session was on the Sites of South Cobb. Looking forward to having sessions in the future about homebuying, financial literacy, first-aid, etc.
