- Goal #2: By the end of 2023-2024 school year, 6th-8th grade students scoring below levels on Scholastic Mathematics Inventory will reduce by 25% measured by the 4th quarter SMI assessment.
- Goal #3: By the end of 2023-2024 school year, 8th grade students scoring proficient and distinguished on the Physical Science EOG will increase from 23% to 30% and 6th-7th grade students scoring proficient and distinguished on interim assessments will increase from 10% to 25%.
- Goal #4: By the end of 2023-2024 school year, 8th grade students scoring proficient and distinguished on the EOG Social Studies Milestones wll increase from 13% to 19%.
