

NCHS Parking Procedures – Spring Semester 2022

Students will not be issued an individual parking space number. Students who have obtained a parking permit for Spring Semester 2022 may park in any of the designated student parking zones (*the lower lot near the Arena on the north side of campus or the lot on the south side of campus nearest to the traffic light at the corner of Old 41 Hwy. and Nowlin Road*).

Parking on campus is a privilege. The administration reserves the right to have the vehicle towed at the owner's expense if a student has received multiple parking citations with the possibility of revocation of parking privileges for remainder of the school year. Students will be notified after receiving their 3rd parking citation that upon a 4th citation, their vehicle will be towed. The contact information for the towing company is; K.O. Checklist: If any one of the following is incomplete...your application WILL NOT be accepted. No exceptions will be made.

____ All information requested on Application is entered, i.e., VIN #, Tag #, Driver's License #, School Site, etc.

____ Parking permit Application signed by: **PARENT & STUDENT**

____ Truancy form signed by: **PARENT & STUDENT**

____ Copy of Student's driver's license. It must be **current and Georgia ONLY.**

____ \$50.00 (options: cash, check, money order or MyPayments Plus)

____ Copy of Student's **current proof of insurance** at the time of application. This document must reflect insurance company's name, telephone #, policy #, date/term of coverage and the vehicle the student will be driving on campus.

Applications will not be accepted or processed if you have an unpaid parking fine, a returned check from previous school years, or any late textbooks/fines from either a classroom or the media center.

It is your responsibility to be prepared to pay these items with a separate check, cash, money order or MyPaymentsPlus transaction.

Please pay close attention to the dates on insurance card & vehicle reflected. It is the #1 reason why applications are rejected.

Frequently Asked Questions

MAY I LAMINATE MY DECAL? No. Laminated decals will be considered "Void". You will receive a fine and be required to purchase another 1st car decal at full price. (Pull paper off back of decal and adhere to passenger's side front windshield.)

MAY SOMEONE ELSE BRING MY APPLICATION IN FOR ME OR PICK UP MY DECAL? Yes. However, it is your responsibility to be certain the application is complete with all signatures, copies, no outstanding fines, etc. It is their responsibility to give you your decal. No "lost" decals will be honored.

"Lost" decal = \$50.00

Additional Parking and Driving Expectations:

In addition to the parking guidelines outlined on the parking application, North Cobb Administration expects all drivers and passengers to conduct themselves in a responsible manner while driving on NCHS property.

All student drivers should understand that the following violations may result in their loss of parking privileges:

1. Parking in the incorrect parking zones designated for students. Student designated parking zones (two lower lots to the left of the gym/wrestling room on the north side of campus).
2. Suspension for any drug, alcohol, or weapons violation.
3. Leaving, attempting to leave, or coming on campus without checking out/in through the attendance office.
4. Reckless driving (includes speeding through any part of the parking lot).
5. Entering the bus port area before or after school without direction from administration.
6. Excessive tardies.
7. Excessive parking tickets.
8. Improperly displayed decal. Decals must be correctly affixed on the passenger's side low on the windshield of the car that is registered.
