- School Strategic Plan 2022-2023

- a. Local Goal- Strengthen Tier I Instruction through the use of Summarization Strategies & STEAM Implementation- **We have made great progress in utilization of STEAM and Summarization to support a solid foundation for Tier I Instruction.**
- b. Feeder Goal- Support a positive school culture through Schoolwide Positive Behavior Plan, which includes a focus on actively teaching behavior expectations and reinforcing positive behavior through student incentives and rewards as well as community service. **Teachers have actively supported the schoolwide plan through the use of Caught Ya Cards and weekly drawings. The school has also done schoolwide drawings for chick-fil-a biscuits or ice cream passes. Our PTSA has actively supported our Fresh Air Fridays and helped to raise funds to support student incentives and rewards.**

- School Strategic Plan 2023-2024

- a. Literacy Goal- ELA teachers and Guiding Coalition are working to develop next year's literacy goals. One goal will likely focus on writing with a specific focus on organization and idea development, as measured by teacher-developed common classroom assessments. There will also be a focus on moving more students to higher level of reading proficiency, based on RI data.
