## Why Do You Want to Graduate Early?

 If it is to begin college earlier or start your career training earlier, have you considered taking dual enrollment classes instead of graduating early? ### Who Can Request to Graduate Early?

- 2. Rising SENIORS (current 11<sup>th</sup>) can REQUEST to graduate at the end of the first semester of their senior year (December 2024).
- 3. Rising JUNIORS (current 10th) can REQUEST to graduate at the end of their junior year (May 2025).

### How Do I Request to Graduate Early?

- Submit a request to see your counselor. You can access the link by stopping by the School Counseling Office or going to our website: <u>www.cobbk12.org/campbellhs</u> > FIND IT FAST> Counseling > Our Team > Click on the link below your counselor's name
- 2. Complete the **REQUEST TO GRADUATE EARLY (3<sup>rd</sup> year)** or the **DECEMBER GRADUATION INTENT** (4<sup>th</sup> year) form provided by your counselor and return it **by March 27 at Noon**.

#### How Do I Know If My Request Is Approved?

- 1. Rising **SENIORS** will be notified by their school counselor once their transcript has been reviewed and it is determined that they can take all the classes they need first semester. The counselor will make all needed changes to their schedule.
- Rising JUNIORS will be notified by their school counselor once their request has been reviewed by the principal (Dr. Watkins) and the CCSD Office of Accountability. If approved, the counselor will contact the student and then make all needed changes to their schedule.

**NOTE:** If denied, your counselor will still notify you to discuss alternative options such as Dual Enrollment, Cobb Horizon, etc.
