What is standard school attire? Students are dressed in a similar fashion, not necessarily the same exact clothes.

What does research suggest? Research suggests that there is a direct correlation between student attire, confidence, achievement, and behavior.

What will it do for our students? The standard attire requirement will enable students to model appropriate dress that reflects a positive appearance, which will assist in the development of positive character and sense of pride.

The students at Sanders Elementary may wear the items listed below.

Please review the additional reminders as we want our students to look and feel their best:

*Leggings/Jeggings are allowed UNDER skirts and jumpers ONLY.

*Pants, skirts, shorts, and skorts must be worn at the waist level.

*Jumpers, shorts, skirts, and skorts must be of an appropriate length depending on your student's height.

*We recommend that the length is not more than 3 inches above the knee and should follow CCSD Dress Code Policy.

* All dress down days will be announced in advance.

*Sweatshirts/jackets may be worn; however, **the hood attached to the sweatshirt should not be worn on the student's head while on school property.**

*Low cut, spaghetti strap shirts/dresses or crop tops *should not* be worn.

*All clothing *should not* have any profanity, slurs, or inappropriate statements.

Sanders students are allowed to participate in spirit days each **Friday**. **On spirit days/dress down days students may wear standard school attire or a Sanders t-shirt and jeans.**

Process for students in violation of the Standard School Attire dress code:

1. The first INCIDENT will require that a reminder note is sent home with the student.
2. The second INCIDENT will require that the student is sent to the counselor for a conference.
3. The third INCIDENT will require the parent/guardian is contacted by the counselor/social worker. If correct sizes are available, the student will be provided appropriate clothing from the uniform closet.
4. The fourth INCIDENT will require a call from the counselor or principal designee to the parent/guardian and the parent will be asked to bring appropriate uniform clothing to school for their student.

*** Our uniform closet has limited supplies and is stocked by donations from the Sanders community, families, and staff.***

At the beginning of the school year, the students will have a one-week transition period to follow the uniform guidelines. All new students enrolling in Sanders Elementary during the school year will have a one-week transition period to follow the uniform guidelines. Thank you for working with us at Sanders so we can ensure our students are successful and will show STAR behavior each day.
