What is our uniform or standard school attire? Students are dressed in a similar fashion, not necessarily the same exact clothes.

What does research suggest? Research suggests that there is a direct correlation between student attire, confidence, achievement, and behavior.

What will it do for our students? The uniform requirement will enable students to model appropriate dress that reflects a positive appearance, which will assist in the development of positive character and sense of pride.

Please review the additional requirements as we want our students to look and feel their best:

- Leggings may ONLY be worn under jumpers, dresses, shorts, or skirts. Leggings must be solid black, navy, white or gray. Leggings may not be worn as a stand-alone uniform bottom.
- Sweatshirts, jackets, or blazers worn during the day in the school building must be SOLID colored and can bear the Sanders logo or not. No hats in the halls of Sanders. Hoodies may be worn, but the hood should not be worn inside the school building.
- o Pants, skirts, shorts, and skorts must be worn at the waist level.
- Jumpers, shorts, skirts, and skorts must be of an appropriate length depending on your student's height. We recommend that the length is not more than 3 inches above the knee and should follow CCSD Dress Code Policy.
- o Low cut, spaghetti strap shirts/dresses or crop tops should not be worn.
- o No clothing should have any profanity, slurs, or inappropriate statements.
- Students are expected to wear their uniforms on Monday through Thursday and may wear jeans with Sanders spirit wear on Fridays.
- All dress down days will be announced in advance.

Thank you for working with us at Sanders so we can ensure our students are successful and will show STAR behavior each day.
