READING INVENTORY (RI)/MATH INVENTORY (MI)

Cobb County School District administers the Reading Inventory (RI) and Math Inventory (MI) to all students in grades K-9 a minimum of three times a year. RI and MI are research-based, adaptive diagnostics that meet each individual student where they are. RI measures reading comprehension skills and longitudinal progress from kindergarten through college readiness. MI tracks math readiness progression from kindergarten through Algebra II. At Simpson, we use the data collected from these assessments as one of several data points to ensure that students are placed in classes that best meet their needs.
