AVID prepares <u>high-potential</u> students to complete a <u>rigorous</u> high school curriculum in an effort to make them college and career ready. The <u>AVID Elective</u> class is designed to increase students' achievement, develop skills in writing for learning, achieve success in honors and AP classes, and become an effective learner in groups. The mission of AID is the "close the achievement gap by preparing all students for college readiness and success in a global society." AVID (Advancement via Individual Determination) is a four-year elective class offered to students who would like to prepare for entrance into a four-year university. The curriculum features writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, reading, note-taking, study skills and college/career activities. College students are in the classroom as tutors twice a week and field trips are taken to universities. Students must commit to taking notes in classes on a daily basis. Criteria taken into consideration for all applicants include: GPA, interview, citizenship, attendance, state test scores, Student Narrative, and recommendations.
