UNEXCUSED TARDY TO SCHOOL /CLASS (per semester)	
6 th Tardy to School/Class	Administrative referral - Parent contact, 1 Administrative Detention
12 th Tardy to School/Class	Administrative referral – Parent contact, 1 day ISS
18 th Tardy to School/Class	Administrative referral – Parent contact, 2 days of ISS
24 th Tardy to School/Class	Administrative Referral – Parent contact, 3 days of ISS
30 th (and all other increments of 6) Tardy to School/Class	Administrative Referral – Parent contact, 5 days of ISS, and contact social worker

ABSENCE POLICY

EXCUSED ABSENCES – Students must turn in absence note to Attendance Office within 3 days of returning. The Georgia Board of Ed. states that students may excused from school for the following reasons:

- medical doctor/dentist/psychologist/psychiatrist.
- personally ill and when attendance in school would endanger their health or the health of others.
- serious illness or death of an immediate family member.
- special and recognized religious holiday observed by their faith.
- mandated by order of a governmental agency.
- conditions rendering school attendance impossible or hazardous to their health or safety.
- registration to vote (not to exceed one day).

UNEXCUSED ABSENCES - If a student is absent from school and doesn't turn in an excuse note within 3 days of returning and/or if a student is absent from school due to reason that is not stated above by the Georgia Board of Ed., the absence is considered an unexcused absence.
