# **Principal's Note**

McClure Families,

It was so great to have our students back in the building on Thursday and Friday to kick off this new year of learning! As students returned to McClure, we were deliberate about revisiting our DARE expectations: Determined, Accountable, Respectful, Excellent. Teachers took time to assure students knew what these behaviors look like in the classroom, hallways, restrooms, cafeteria, academically, and socially. On Friday, the administrative team met with each grade level to not only reiterate these expectations but to deliver the message that our expectations for students increase the longer they are enrolled at McClure. Our 6<sup>th</sup> grade students are no longer new to us, our 7<sup>th</sup> graders have been with us a year and a half, and our 8<sup>th</sup> graders have almost been with us three whole years! So, we challenged each grade level to increase the expectation of themselves regarding behavior, academics, and social interactions with one another. Our message was that, while 95% of our students had ZERO behavior infractions during the first semester and 65% made the honor roll, we can always do better! Thank you for your work supporting this same message at home. This collaborative work is why we are *Best in the West!*
