- McClure Tutoring Every week there are multiple sessions in each grade level where students can get additional help either before or after school.

6th Grade Parents – Heads Up! All rising 7th grade students are required to have one dose of the Tdap and meningococcal vaccines to attend school. Once your child has received the required vaccines, please send a copy of the completed Georgia Department of Public Health Certificate of Immunization Form 3231 to McClure. It can be emailed to summer.lundberg@cobbk12.org or dropped off to the front office. Per Georgia law, in order for your child to remain in school, a completed immunization record must be on file for your child by the first day of the new school year. 6th grade parents, it's never too early to start planning ahead!
