High School Classes – At McClure, 8th grade students have the opportunity to take high school classes and earn high school credit. Placement for some of these classes, like Algebra and Physical Science, automatically occurs based on the successful completion of prerequisite courses in 6th and 7th grades. Others, such as foreign language and Leadership & Law, have a list of requirements including standardized testing data. Students who qualify for these courses received communication through CTLS on Friday, 4/21. One course that ALL 7th grade students can apply to take in 8th grade is High School Visual Art. If you have a student interested in Ms. Heyser's year-long art course, they must submit sample artwork and complete the Art Application. The deadline to apply for high school courses in 8th grade is Sunday, May 7th and 11:59pm.
