Carpool Pickup – Parents, thank you for working with our team to keep the afternoon carpool line moving quickly each day. We have nearly every student picked up each day before 4:40! One additional note: Around 4:00 each afternoon, we begin running our carpool line through the Bullard parking lot so that our buses can get into our campus. Usually, the amazing Officer Norah helps with this. Thank you for continuing this practice on days she is not available to support us!

Scoliosis Screening – We will have scoliosis screening for all 6th & 8th grade students on Thursday, October 19th. Your child will receive an opt-out form this coming Tuesday in homeroom. If you do not want your child to be screened by the school or your child has already been screened by his/her primary care physician, please fill out the opt-out form by checking the appropriate box and signing at the bottom. This form needs to be turned in as soon as possible. If you do not turn the official form in to school your child will be screened on October 19th. Due to county requirements, you must opt-out using the Official #4400 Form provided. We cannot accept handwritten notes or emails.

Lunch Accounts – Now that we are into the school year, it is a good time to check <u>MyPaymentsPlus</u> to assure your student has money on their lunch account. At McClure, we assure every student eats every day. However, they get more choices when they have funds in their accounts.
