Round Up – Beginning the week after Labor Day, McClure will have a weekly Round Up session for our students. "What is Round Up?" you ask. Round Up is a weekly opportunity for our teachers to pull students who need additional support with the content they are currently learning. We call this Tier 2 instruction. If you didn't get it the first time, we can try it again in Round Up! One pleasant side effect of Tier 2 instruction is that it also provides time for extension and enrichment of students who do not require additional support. For these students, they can choose where they go for Round Up and a variety of options are provided throughout our building. The best part? Round Up is fluid every week so students are continually getting what they need, even if it is different than the week before.
