### **Operational**

September Calendar – Keep up with all things McClure this month by watching the McClure September Calendar of events.

- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Tributes Eighth grade parents, honor your student's middle school years with a tribute ad in the yearbook! Log on to the <u>Yearbook Order Center</u> to custom design your ad soon. They are only available for a short time period and space is limited.
- Proof of Enrollment If your student needs proof of school enrollment for sports, please send a request to the attendance email, mccluremssupport@cobbk12.org. Ms. Summer Lundberg will print the form and send it home with your student.
- Free & Reduced Lunch If your student received free and reduced lunch last year, the grace period for this year ends September 13<sup>th</sup>. So, on September 14<sup>th</sup> they will be charged full price if they haven't filled out a new application for this school year. The USDA only allows a 30-day grace period before a new application must be submitted. After that period of time expires, students will automatically go to full pay. You can contact <u>Ms. Lisa Lovern</u>, the McClure Café Manager, or see <u>This Site</u> for details on how to apply.
- **DARE Day** Our next DARE Day is coming up this Friday, September 15. This event will cost students 40 PBIS Rewards points to attend.
- Scoliosis Screening We will have scoliosis screening for all 6th & 8th grade students on Thursday, October 19th. If you do not want your child to be screened by the school or your child has already been screened by his/her primary care physician, please fill out the opt-out form by checking the appropriate box and signing at the bottom. This form needs to be turned in as soon as possible. If you do not turn the official form in to school your child will be screened on October 19th. Due to county requirements, you must opt-out using the Official #4400 Form provided. We cannot accept handwritten notes or emails.
- **Cognia Parent Survey** Every five years our school district goes through a reaccreditation process. Part of that process involves survey data from staff members, students and parents. The Cognia Student, Parent, and Staff Surveys are designed to collect data on student academic learning and wellness during the current school year. Participation in each survey is anonymous and voluntary, and participation is highly encouraged. The survey results will provide the Cognia Accrediting Agency, Cobb County School District, and local schools with data regarding student learning environment, staff input, and parent feedback to support continuous learning. Please take a moment to complete the <u>Parent Survey</u>.
- **Cognia Student Survey** As referenced above, each student will complete the Cognia Student Survey sometime this week, September 11-15. The survey questions can be seen <u>Here</u> for your review.
- **High School Football Games** Football season is upon us! This means that many of our Mavericks will be in attendance at high school football games across the county. If your middle school child plans on attending high school football games, there are a few expectations of which you need be aware:
  - Admission of middle school students requires an adult chaperone.
  - While attending the event, appropriate behavior is expected. Failure to follow rules or staff directions can have students removed from the event or result in school consequences.
  - At the conclusion of play, all students are expected to exit the stadium within 20 minutes.

At McClure, we are known as the middle school whose students have the best behavior wherever we go. We get compliments from high school principals saying, "I always know who the McClure kids are because they are the most polite and have the best behavior."
