# **Operational**

- Social Media One of the main reasons for our upgraded <u>Cell Phone Policy</u> this year is due to issues we see and hear about on social media. Most platforms (Instagram, Twitter, Facebook, Snapchat etc.) require users to be 13 years or older. However, we know that many of our students that are under 13 still have accounts on social media. Middle school students struggle with the anonymity available via social media and some unfortunately choose to say unkind things to their peers and about their peers. Here are some recommendations to assure your student is using their phone appropriately:
  - Look through their social media accounts Most communication is not through text messages, it's through social media. So, check Instagram, Snapchat, and TikTok to see who they are following and what they are saying.
  - Educate yourself on how to look for multiple accounts on the same app. Many students will have the account they show their parents, but then also have other accounts.
  - Share your best practices with us! If you find something that really works, share it with us at school and we can spread the word!
- **Code Red Drill** Our number one goal at McClure Middle School is to ensure safety for all. On Wednesday, September 7, 2022, we will have our code red drill. During this drill, we will activate our Centigex system that will give specific instructions on what teachers and students should do in the case of an emergency. Our administrators will go over how it will sound and reteach expectations for the drill the day before (tomorrow). We practice all safety drills seriously so that students know exactly what to do if we ever have an emergency at McClure Middle School.
