

HOW TO REQUEST A TRANSCRIPT

CURRENT STUDENTS

Follow the instructions below to request Official Transcripts for Colleges, NCAA, NAIA and Scholarships.

- Log into Naviance https://tinyurl.com/CCSDNaviance
 - Visit www.mceachernhigh.org
 - Click "Find It Fast" Top Right Corner
 - Click "Naviance"
 - Enter Your McEachern/Cobb County Office 365 User Name & Password (The log-in you use for a school computer).
- In Naviance Click "Colleges" then "Colleges I'm applying to".
- If you have completed the College Admissions Application Click the White Plus Mark in the hot pink circle to add colleges to your Naviance account.
- Complete the information fields Click "Save".
- For Scholarships or if you have <u>NOT</u> completed the College Admissions Application Click 1) "Manage Transcripts" under "Colleges I'm applying to", 2) the white plus mark in the hot pink circle, 3) "Other Transcript", 4) complete the form fields and then 5) "Request and Finish".

To Pay For Transcripts

- All Transcripts are \$2 Each.
- Pay Online Student or Enrolling Adult Must Log-In/Create a MyPaymentsPlus Account (www.mypaymentsplus.com).
- Pay In-Person Visit the Counseling Office in the Business Technology (BT) Building.
- The Student or Enrolling Adult must bring Picture ID.

All Current Students must add the College(s) to their Naviance Account before making payments for transcripts.

2019 & 2020 GRADUATES

- Visit the Counseling Office in the Business Technology Building.
- The Student or Enrolling Adult must bring picture ID.
- Printed Official Transcripts are \$2 Each.

2018 & EARLIER GRADUATES

Records for graduates from McEachern High School prior to 2019 are held at the Cobb County Records Center. You can obtain transcripts and records by calling (770) 514-3872 or by ordering Online. Visit the CCSD website (www.cobbk12.org) -
