#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### Do I have to have a job?

Yes, you should have a job by the first week of school. It can be paid or unpaid. However, due to current circumstances, we can be flexible.

#### Can you help me find a job?

Yes. If I get information about companies that are hiring, I will pass it on to you. Ultimately it is your responsibility to find a job.

#### Do I need a car?

You should have reliable transportation and a driver's license OR a reliable person who will take you to work. You must leave the building during your WBL period.

#### How many periods of Work-Based can I do?

Up to 2 class periods

#### Do I have to work everyday?

No, but you must work at least 5-15 hours/week for each period class of WBL, and you must leave campus.

#### Can I do Dual Enrollment and Work-Based Learning?

YES! They are a perfect match, since we only meet once a month. You don't have to be on campus (LHS) every day for WBL.
